Judge Rapp (retired) has served as an elected Associate Circuit Judge, and designated Circuit Judge. He was Chief Judge of the 15th Judicial Circuit and was elected Chairman of the Conference of Chief Judges. He was appointed as Justice of the Illinois Appellate Court and was a member of the Judicial Inquiry Board.
